Habitat for Humanity Lesotho partners with other Habitat for Humanity Affiliates from abroad to build the strength, stability and self-reliance needed by Mosonngoa and her family.

Habitat for Humanity Lesotho among others, works in partnership with individuals, communities and organizations to provide decent and affordable housing for vulnerable groups (which include, orphaned, people with disabilities and the elderly) that could not afford to own a safe, decent and affordable place to call home. Generally, voluntarism is one of the major driving forces for the organization's success in addressing poverty housing in Lesotho. For instance, through volunteerism, Habitat for Humanity Lesotho has managed to hand up (not hand down) shelter for over 3 000 households in the country. To date, we have hosted **41** and about **20** local volunteer teams have been hosted.

On the 9th February 2020, a team of 9 volunteers from Habitat St. Vrain Valley (USA) and Habitat Paraguay led by Julie Galegos will arrive in Lesotho to partner with Mosonngoa Mohono and her family to raise walls of their Habitat Home. The construction of a two roomed house, VIP latrine and soakaway pit will commence on Monday 10th to 14th February 2020 at Kolonyama Ha-Rampa village. (*see attached family profile*)

Habitat for Humanity Lesotho and the team will hold a house dedication ceremony for Mosonngoa Mohono and her family on the 14th February, 2020, from 11:30am – 12:30pm. The event will mark the success of yet another volunteer work and a dream come true for the Mohono family. As in the past similar events, Mosonngoa and her family's lives will be transformed as they will have a safe and decent place to call home.
